This week of focus on the treatment of Palesitnians by the Israeli state comes at a precarious time for the indigenous people of the region. It has been a year since the mass destruction of Gaza by Israeli military forces and the blockade has continued along with increasing settlement, housing evictions, and demolitions directed at displacing the Palestinian people from the West Bank and East Jerusalem. Please join us for special talk on Palestine by world renowned intellectual, Noam Chomsky, as he addresses one of the most important issues of our time.

Noam Chomsky: prolific author and Institute Professor Emeritus at MIT, the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, where he taught for over half a century. Among his many dozens of books are Rogue States: The Rule of Force in World Affairs, The New Military Humanism: Lessons from Kosovo, Fateful Triangle: The United States, Israel, and the Palestinians, Manufacturing Consent, Necessary Illusions: Thought Control in Democratic Societies, and Failed States: T[http://img2.meetupsta...](#) Abuse of Power and the Assault on Democracy. Israeli Apartheid Week (IAW) is an annual international series of events held in cities and campuses across the globe. The aim of IAW is to educate people about the nature of Israel as an apartheid system and to build Boycott, Divestment, and Sanctions (BDS) campaigns as part of a growing global BDS movement.

Last year, more than 40 cities around the world participated in the week's activities, which took place in the wake of Israel's brutal assault against Palestinians in the Gaza Strip. IAW continues to grow with new cities joining this year.
