UC Alumni Asking UC Regents to Recognize that Anti-Zionism is Modern Anti-Semitism

Dear UC Regents:

We are 628 University of California alumni who are deeply concerned about the welfare of Jewish students at our alma mater. While we have always been proud of our school, we are gravely concerned about the frightening rise in anti-Semitic incidents on campus, many of which have made national headlines over the past year.

We would like to thank you for your leadership and actions to address campus anti-Semitism – and other forms of bigotry – by drafting a Statement of Principles Against Intolerance that better defines intolerance for minority communities.

We can all agree that the anti-Semitism plaguing Jewish students at UC must stop. UC must once again become a place where Jewish students feel safe. However, to accomplish

this, we must acknowledge that anti-Zionism is in fact modern anti-Semitism. Today's anti-Semitism is not as obvious as swastikas and historical anti-Jewish slurs. It is often cloaked in anti-Zionist behaviors and demonstrations that seek to deny Jews the right to self-determination, blame the only Jewish state for all evil in the world, and spread hatred about the Jewish people and the Jewish state.

The recent statements by UCLA student and employee Lisa Marie Mendez clearly illustrate the problem. What began as anti-Israel expression quickly devolved into classic anti-Semitism and the targeting of all Jews regardless of their feelings on Israel. Sadly, this is a common thread throughout the bulk of anti-Semitism at UC. Criticism and debate on Israel's policies – like any debate – is certainly welcome and encouraged on a college campus. However, far too often, criticism about Israel crosses the line into blatant anti-Semitism. In fact, acts which directly harm or threaten Jewish students, including physical and verbal assaults, destruction of property, harassment, discrimination, and defamation, are increased in schools where anti-Zionist activity is high.

Those who are largely responsible for the anti-Semitism on campus will try to hide behind the First Amendment, claiming we are attempting to curtail free speech. **This could not be further from the truth.** Scholarly debate is critical. And the vast majority of UC students are not anti-Semites. However, too many in the campus community don't understand that there is a distinction between criticism of Israel's policies and anti-Zionism.

We urge you to take a strong stance against anti-Semitism by acknowledging a distinction between criticism of Israel's policies and calls for the destruction of Israel which are anti-Semitic. A Statement merely condemning anti-Semitism without recognizing that anti-Zionism is modern anti-Semitism and breeds classic anti-Semitism on campus will do nothing to improve the climate for Jewish students who are currently under siege.

Thank you once again for your leadership, courage, and moral compass to do the right thing.

Daniel (UC San Francisco) – “Stop the hate! We need to recognize the layers of Anti-Semitism and how BDS and other activities like "checkpoints" are targeting Jewish students.”

Debra (UC Berkeley) – “I deplore the depth to which discourse has fallen on our UC campuses. My grandchildren deserve a place of intellectual curiosity, not physical and psychological intimidation. Thank you for your vote to uphold the dignity of all students and the reputation of our august institution.”

Mollee (UC Berkeley) – “I attended the UC Regents meeting in Irvine during which thoughtful comments were made by the Regents. I was there as a parent of a UCLA student in attendance. Now is the time to put those thoughtful comments into action and to make Jewish students feel safe on UC campuses.”

David (UC Berkeley Law) – “This is a very important issue. It is actually not very hard to distinguish criticism of Israel's policies from pure anti-Semitism cloaked in the mantle of BDS or other labels that attempt to obscure attacks that ultimately boil down to the denial of the rights of one group (Jews) to assert the same rights of self-determination and peoplehood as everyone else...[It] is a hostile and threatening environment directed at one religious and ethnic group and UC needs to do much more to set appropriate limits on such harassment.”

I am discouraging my grandson from attending a UC campus. Jewish kids matter too.”

Renee (UC Berkeley) – “My son just graduated from UC Berkeley on December 20, 2015. He photographed numerous drawings of swastikas in various men's bathrooms on the campus and reported them to campus police. A number of students on campus have said to him, ‘You're a Jew? With a Swedish first name, Nils?’”

Nils (UC Berkeley) *This is the son mentioned above.* – “On numerous occasions I saw drawings of swastikas in the men's bathrooms. My mother came to campus one day and also saw them in the women's bathrooms at Sproul Hall and in Dwinelle. I have often heard people make anti-Semitic remarks.”

Leslee (UCLA) – “As an undergraduate, I belonged to a Jewish sorority, and would never have dreamed that it is now challenging for a Jewish student to wear a mark of identification on campus. Please stop this hate speech and acts of incitement making it difficult for today's Jewish students. So sad about what is occurring at my much adored UCLA campus!”

Robert (UC Berkeley)– “Been following the anti-Semitism on UC campuses for years now in disbelief with zero intervention on the part of the Regents. The time to put a stop to this is today.”
