More than 5,000 UC Stakeholders and Supporters Urge UC Regents to Ensure Campus Administrators Enforce University Policy and State Law Prohibiting Faculty Abuse

To the Regents of the University of California,

As evidenced by the recent *Algemeiner* article, "How Anti-Zionist Faculty Captured a University of California Campus and What It Means for the Future of Jews in America," anti-Zionist faculty are out of control at the University of California. They are using their academic positions, departmental infrastructure and university resources to spread virulent hatred of the Jewish state and its on-campus supporters, and in so doing, they are inciting the harassment and even assault of Jewish students - all with impunity.

Campus administrators are simply not enforcing university policies and state laws that clearly prohibit such faculty abuse.
