Supporting ASUC's Divestment from Weapons Manufacturers and Corporations Violating BDS

WHEREAS, for over seventy-five years, Israel has occupied Palestine and since October 7, 2023, Israel has launched a genocidal assault on Gaza, leading to the deaths of nearly 186,000 Palestinians as of July 2024—a number that likely underrepresents the number of deaths¹. Recent airstrikes, including those on al-Mawasi and al-Nuseirat camp on September 10 and 11 respectively², indicate that these figures are outdated, and as such, will continue to rise. The hermetic blockade, which has deliberately cut off access to essential resources such as food, water, fuel, electricity, and medical supplies, has caused the starvation of over two million civilians and prevented critical medical assistance. At the same time, military strikes have targeted Palestinians seeking humanitarian aid³, bombed hospitals like al-Amal hospital and al-Khair hospital⁴, and attacked refugee camps⁵; and

WHEREAS, amid the current onslaught on Palestinian territorial sovereignty, Israel has accelerated the rate at which it illegally encroaches upon the West Bank, seizing more land in 2024 than in the last 20 years combined,⁶ the latest in an ongoing series of breaches of international law by Israel;⁷ and

WHEREAS, on October 16, 2023, Palestinian trade unions issued a plea for workers around the globe to “end all forms of complicity with Israel’s crimes — most urgently halting the arms trade with Israel, as well as all funding and military research;”⁸ and on November 29, 2023, fifteen Palestinian institutions of higher education co-signed a letter calling for “an end to 75 years of Israel’s regime of settler-colonial oppression and apartheid;”⁹ echoing long-standing calls from historic coalitions of Palestinian civil society and political organizations in 2005 by the Boycott National Committee for “Boycott, Divestment and Sanctions (BDS) against Israel Until it Complies

with International Law and Universal Principles of Human Rights”¹⁰ and in 2004 by the Palestinian Campaign for the Academic and Cultural Boycott of Israel to “boycott ... events, activities, agreements, or projects involving Israeli academic institutions or that otherwise promote the normalization of Israel in the global academy;”¹¹ and,

WHEREAS, in 2013¹² and 2024¹³, the ASUC formally committed to “The Boycott, Divestment, and Sanctions (BDS) movement,” specifically in the context of the University of California (UC) system, and at UC Berkeley itself; and

WHEREAS, in May 2024, the GA passed [Resolution #2404A](#) endorsing BDS in the context of the UC system and called on “any GA funds managed by the GA directly, the Berkeley Foundation, the University of California Regents through the UC Office of the President” that are found to be enabling and profiting from the Israeli occupation of Palestinian land to be divested¹⁴; and

WHEREAS, this GA bill was passed with almost 3500 co-sponsors, including undergraduate students, graduate students, post-docs alumni, faculty, staff, and community members, demonstrating popular support at UC Berkeley for divestment; and

WHEREAS, in 2014,¹⁵ in 2021,¹⁶ and in January 2024,¹⁷ UAW 4811 (formerly UAW 2865 and UAW 5810), the union serving all Academic Student Employees, Postdocs, and Academic Researchers, reaffirmed its commitment to the movement to BDS; and in January 2024,¹⁸ the Berkeley campus unit of UAW 4811 formed a BDS Exploratory Committee to, in part, investigate the ties of UC to companies and institutions which manufacture weapons, profit off of the Israeli occupation, or otherwise are targets of the BDS movement; and

WHEREAS, we, as undergraduate students, benefit from the labor of UAW members and over 1000 undergraduate students at the Berkeley campus alone are UAW tutors, readers, and instructors, and thereby express solidarity with the endeavors of the UAW 4811 to this end; and

WHEREAS, the UAW 4811’s BDS exploratory committee has identified UC’s direct investments in the weapons manufacturers General Electric and Honeywell International, both of which directly arm and sustain the occupation and genocide of Palestinians; this committee has also identified UC’s direct investments in Exxon, which has directly supplied fuel to the Israeli airforce, and in Coca Cola, whose Israeli subsidiary primarily operates in illegal settlements in occupied East Jerusalem and the Syrian Golan Heights; and this committee has also discovered that the vast majority of the UC’s funds are held indirectly through index funds, hedge funds, and other large asset managers, rendering its financial portfolio more heavily yet opaquely invested in weapons manufacturers and other companies profiting from the Israeli occupation of Palestine; and,

WHEREAS, in April 2024, a broad coalition of over one hundred organizations based at UC Berkeley representing tens of thousands of students, faculty, staff, and alumni formed the UC Berkeley Divest Coalition, demanding: (i) “the total divestment of the UC Berkeley Foundation and the UC General Endowment Pool from the Israeli state and from all companies profiting from the colonization of Palestine,” beginning immediately with any and all direct or indirect investments in “weapons manufacturers that arm and sustain the genocide in Gaza, including Raytheon, Lockheed Martin, and General Electric;” (ii) that “UC Berkeley, including student groups and government, boycott all products and services that are complicit in the occupation and genocide of Palestinians, as specified by the BDS movement;” and (iii) that “UC Berkeley and its researchers” join the Palestinian Campaign for the Academic and Cultural Boycott of Israel (PACBI), and “sever all ties to Israeli academic and cultural institutions;”¹⁹ and,

WHEREAS, in accordance with [SR 23/24-042](#), the ASUC has a duty to call on UC Berkeley “to take concrete steps to protect Palestinian students and their right to exist, provide adequate resources, condemn hate and harassment towards Palestinian students and their allies, and accurately investigate discriminatory behavior against Palestinian students,” all of which UC Berkeley has been failing to do;²⁰ and

WHEREAS, in [SR 24/25-001](#), the ASUC identified “holding campus administrators accountable to diversity, equity, inclusion, belonging, and justice” as an objective for the 2024-2025 school year as a part of its advocacy agenda²¹; and

WHEREAS, UC’s direct and indirect financial ties to companies complicit in the occupation and genocide of Palestinians, its ongoing ties to Israeli academic and cultural institutions, and its failure to combat anti-Palestinianism on our campus, systematically marginalize Palestinian students, threaten their physical and emotional safety, and actively contribute to the destruction of their identity, culture, traditions, and community; and

WHEREAS, the ASUC, in accordance with [SR 23/24-057](#), [SR 23/24-042](#), and its advocacy agenda as outlined in [SR 24/25-001](#), has a duty to take strong measures to protect Palestinian students, to sever all direct and indirect ties with the occupation and genocide of Palestinians, and to leverage its institutional position to advocate for an end to the occupation and genocide; and such measures are now all the more warranted and urgent given the overwhelming support for BDS and the Palestinian people among UC Berkeley graduate students specifically, and in the campus community more broadly, as reflected in the reiterated positions and actions of the ASUC itself, the GA, and in the broad coalition of student and campus organizations that has recently formed to advocate for UC’s divestment from the Israeli occupation of Palestine.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the ASUC formally join the UC Berkeley BDS Coalition, sign on to the [UC Berkeley BDS Coalition Statement](#),²² and advocate for its demands as stated therein and in accordance with [SR 23/24-057](#); and be it further

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that, in line with joining the aforementioned BDS coalition, the ASUC President and ASUC External Affairs Vice President are directed to appoint 2 delegates (1 delegate each) to represent the position of the ASUC in said coalition; and

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the ASUC adopt a standing policy advocating for an immediate, unconditional, and permanent arms embargo on Israel in accordance with international law²³ as well as release of all Palestinian political prisoners in Israel, advocating the free flow of humanitarian aid to the civilians of Gaza, and condemning in the strongest possible terms the war crimes, including the crimes of collective punishment and such crimes as the ICJ has stated may plausibly amount to the crime of genocide, carried out by the state of Israel during or before this conflict²⁴; and

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, in line with the same declaration in GA [Resolution #2404A](#), the ASUC declare a standing policy to recognize the State of Palestine and call for all United Nations member nations to internationally recognize the State of Palestine, especially the United States; and,

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, in line with the 2005 BDS call that the ASUC has previously signed onto in 2013 and 2024, which calls for an end to Israeli “occupation and colonization of all Arab lands,”²⁵ the ASUC adopt a standing policy to call for an end to the settler-colonial occupation of Palestine; and,

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, in line with the ASUC’s long standing commitment to boycott and divest from companies enabling and profiting from the Israeli occupation of Palestinian land, adopt a standing policy that no ASUC funds shall be invested in any corporation identified in the BDS List²⁶ or the Who Profits Research Center’s database²⁷ of complicit companies or the American Friends Service Committee Occupations Divestment²⁸ list, and organic boycotts as described by the [BDS Movement](#); and

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this standing policy will apply to any and all of the ASUC’s funds that are managed by the ASUC directly or that flow through entities funding, resourcing, and enabling the ongoing genocide in Palestine, including but not limited to Berkeley Foundation, UC Regents, and the UC Office of the President; and

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the ASUC formally condemns the Berkeley Foundation, the University of California Regents, and the UC Office of the President, amongst many other agents, in funding, resourcing, and enabling the ongoing genocide in Palestine; and

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, in line with this policy, the ASUC Chief Financial Officer, the Chair of the ASUC Senate Finance Committee, and the MEMSSA Coalition Senator or Chair be directed to request a full list of companies in which ASUC funds managed by the Berkeley Foundation, the University of California Regents or any other agent have been invested, including direct investments, investments into index funds, and funds managed by private equity firms, immediately upon the passage of this resolution and quarterly hereafter; and

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, in the event that requests reveal ASUC funds are invested in any complicit company in the above list and/or database, the ASUC Chief Financial Officer, the Chair of the ASUC Senate Finance Committee, and the MEMSSA Coalition Chair be directed to immediately request an accounting of the size of these investments, and whether they are held as individual stocks, through index funds or through private equity funds; and

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, in the event that requests reveal ASUC funds are invested in any complicit company in the above list and/or database, the ASUC Chief Financial Officer, the Chair of the ASUC Senate Finance Committee, and the MEMSSA Coalition Chair be directed to immediately request the divestment of said funds from the complicit companies by directing the managing agent to reinvest these funds by liquidating any direct stock holdings in complicit companies, moving any index fund investments involving these companies to “custom” index funds that exclude the list of complicit companies, and/or removing its investment from any private equity firm with substantial ties to weapons manufacturing or which otherwise violates the provisions of the BDS demands; and

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, in the event that the directives set forth by this resolution are not followed, the ASUC Senate shall direct the Chief Financial Officer and any agents managing the compromised ASUC funds and/or ASUC investments to comply with this resolution’s requests; and

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the ASUC President, ASUC Chief Financial Officer, the Chair of the ASUC Senate Finance Committee, and any other relevant officers be directed to inform the Chancellor of the UC Berkeley and any relevant members of the administration of UC Berkeley or the UC Berkeley Foundation of the ASUC’s commitment to a ceasefire in the conflict currently raging in Gaza and the ASUC’s commitment to divest from weapon’s manufacturers, companies which profit from the illegal Israeli occupation, and companies which are targeted by the BDS list; and

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the ASUC President, ASUC External Affairs Vice President, and any other relevant officers be directed to diligently request and push the Chancellor of UC Berkeley and any relevant members of the administration of UC Berkeley or the UC Berkeley Foundation to take significantly similar positions and actions to those hereby taken by the ASUC; and

THEREFORE BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that, for the next three years, the ASUC Chief Financial Officer, the Chair of the ASUC Senate Finance Committee, and the MEMSSA Coalition Chair be directed to provide a report to the ASUC Senate at the fourth Senate meeting of each semester on the progress made to identify, examine, and divest any ASUC funds invested in complicit companies.
